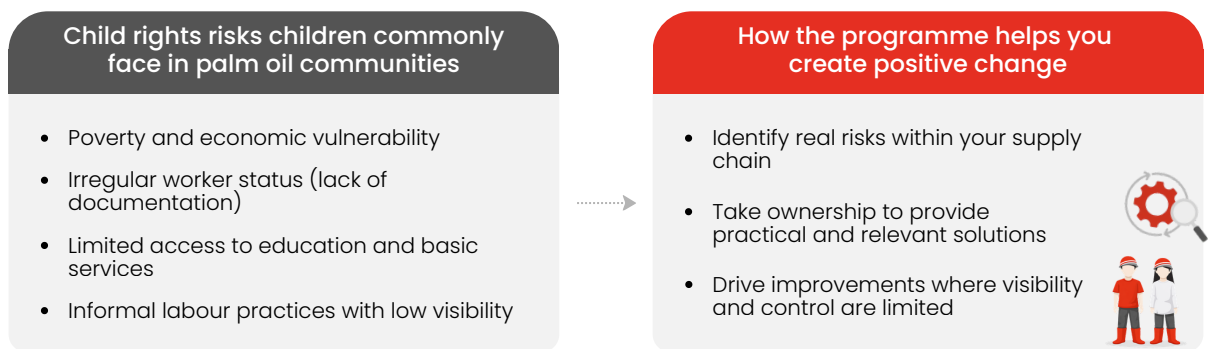


Child Rights Changemaker Programme

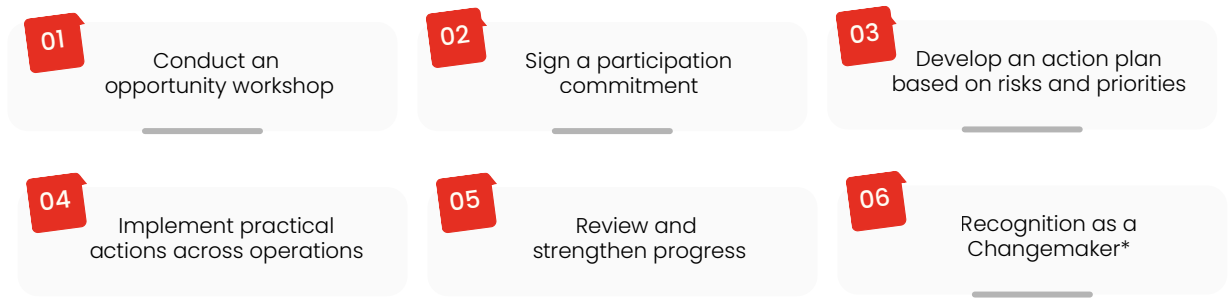
A practical, supplier-led initiative that helps palm oil producers address child rights risks in their supply chains. Recognising realities such as smallholder production, informal labour and complex sourcing networks, it supports producers to assess risks, set context-relevant priorities, engage lower-tier partners and strengthen HRDD practices over time.

Why driving positive change matters

Children in lower-tier supply chains face embedded child rights risks in daily operations that top-down approaches struggle to address. This makes a supplier-led approach essential.



How it works: A six-step guide



(* Impact as a Changemaker is assessed on **three** criteria: (i) benefits children at risk, (ii) supports sustainable change in the palm oil sector; (iii) improves company practices.
